



Staying Mobile As of June of 2012, most college students have a smartphone. This year, students at Grand Valley State University can use their cellphones to avoid large, cumbersome wallets. It's all a part of the Great American Wallet Project. The great American wallet is an ancient invention. "Before plastic, there was the wallet. It was held in a pocket," said Alex Fortin, director of marketing for Oakley. Fortin recently came up with the Great American Wallet Project, a pilot program that focuses on American culture and lifestyle. Some of the pilot program's features include: It is the perfect fit for anyone, any size, any age, and is easily customizable to fit individuals. It is made of recycled materials, durable, and weather resistant. Students and staff members can customize their wallets in a variety of ways, including fabrics and custom colors. "We're giving them a way to express themselves and be more environmentally conscious," said Fortin. To get started, students and staff members must sign up to be a participant and put down a \$10 deposit. Once enrolled, participants receive their wallet(s) the following week. "We expect some of them to last a long time," said Fortin. "Some of them could last throughout their lives." The Great American Wallet is made by a local company, and Oakley is looking for other businesses to create their own wallet, too. So if you want to start a new business, this is your chance to make an impact and give back. "The economy is getting better, but we still have a lot of people out there struggling. If you can't afford a phone, you can't afford any other thing.
