Keep a Photo Editor in Your Suite As with any powerful software, be careful what you write to the hard drive. If you accidentally delete a file, which can happen in a few seconds with Photoshop, you can always recover a file using an undelete utility. (You can also use a recovery tool if you use Windows.) But even if you don't actually delete a file, Photoshop may still change the way you save it. Instead of saving files to the same folder or using a filename that includes the file type, Photoshop may save files to a new folder. And it may even name a file that has a common extension so that it can be mistaken for a completely different file type. You can try to find out what's going on by opening the Preferences dialog box. Photoshop may also save a file in a compressed format. In some cases, the full details about your image may be changed. When you edit a photo, you may indicate that the image is a JPEG in the Save For Web dialog box. If you don't, Photoshop may convert the image to a non-JPEG format, such as the compressed TIFF format. Although you can change the default settings for saving files in the Photoshop preferences, I usually use one of the Photoshop settings to tell Photoshop what to do when saving images. For example, I usually use the Save For Web option to save JPEG files that I am going to share on the Web. The trick is to make sure that you don't automatically change the file format or add details about the file that you don't want. Even if you don't change the file type, you may have added filters or effects that you don't want. For example, the TIFF format has a much larger file size than the JPEG format, so you may not want to add file size and file type information to a TIFF file. Brushes are a major part of the Photoshop package, and they come in a wide range of shapes and sizes. Brushes can even have textures added to them, giving them a more realistic appearance. Start by opening a new document and creating a new layer for all of your brush work. Most of the brushes in the Photoshop Brushes Pack don't work very well when copied onto a new layer, so you may want to create a new layer called a "main layer" and work in the "main layer" for this project. First, select the type of brush you wish to create. For most brushes you may select "Brush Tool" and "Brush Presets." If you have a Brush Preset you wish to use, select the brush's name from the Brush Preset menu. If you want to create your own brush, select "Custom Brush." To create a finish, such as a solid or radial gradient, select the Fill box and then click the button that appears next to it. The gradient selector box appears, where you can select any of the available gradients from the four areas. To adjust the scale of the pattern, click the Scale the Pattern box and then click and drag it up or down. To adjust the color gradient, drag the midpoint on the line from the top to the bottom to adjust the location of the gradient. Click the button that appears next to it to make the gradient continuous. To adjust the color of the gradient, drag the midpoint down on the line from the top
